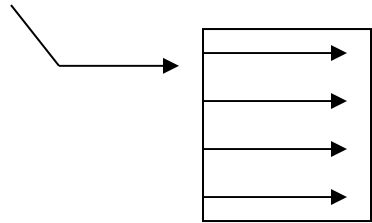


Visual Notebook: Landforms

Directions: label the squares with the **highlighted** landform term with its definition at the bottom of each square. List the terms starting left to right and in alphabetical order with the paper in Portrait mode.

Draw an illustration of each landform and **color it** using map (color) pencils only.

- Friday 15th: **archipelago, atoll** (page 879), **basin, canyon,**
- Monday 18th: **cape, delta, divide, fjord** (page 422),
- Tuesday 19th: **isthmus, mesa, oasis, peninsula,**
- Wednesday 20th: **plateau, river** (includes – source, mouth, & tributary), **strait, valley**
- Thursday 21th: Finalize project (double check your work)
- Friday 22th: Notebook is due

<p>Archipelago – a group or chain of islands clustered together in an ocean or sea</p>	<p>Plateau – area of flat or rolling land at a higher elevation, about 300 – 3000 feet high</p>
